Alpine Waste & Recycling Bids for Bonds Home Run Ball

COMMERCE CITY, Colo. (March 6, 2008) – Alpine Waste & Recycling announced today it will pay \$7,170 to purchase the authenticated baseball that Barry Bonds hit in Denver marking the 762nd home run of Bonds' career.

Bonds hit the home run Sept. 5, 2007 at Coors Field, and the ball has not been seen since then. Bonds went the remainder of the season without hitting another home run, and it stands as the all-time career record home run ball – unless Bonds signs a contract with another Major League team and improves upon his own record.

Alpine, the largest privately held waste disposal company in the Denver area, will display the ball at the company's new Altogether Recycling™ plant in Denver.

“We want to encourage people to visit our Altogether Recycling plant with their recycling materials, and we hope the ball will provide extra incentive for them to make the trip,” said Alpine President John Griffith.

Griffith said he thinks the offering price is fair, because it matches the amount paid for Babe Ruth's final home run ball hit in an exhibition game in 1946.

As a condition of the sale, Alpine will ask that the seller donate 10 percent of the proceeds to ArtSmart, the Arvada Center's arts programs for children.
